

NOTICE TO MEDICAID PATIENTS

This office accepts Medicaid as an insurance carrier for eye health examinations, office visits for diseases of the eye and ocular emergencies.

Medicaid insurance will provide a comprehensive eye health exam and glasses to any person under the age of 21 every twelve (12) months.

Vision Square Eye Care believes all children 18 years and under should be provided with polycarbonate lenses in an effort to provide the safest possible lens for wear. Medicaid will only approve 6 years old and under and special circumstances for polycarbonate lens. If you desire a polycarbonate lens for your child and they are not in the criteria above it is your responsibility to provide your child with this product or accept the product that Medicaid provides. Vision Square Eye Care will accept no liability if any physical damage occurs due to the use of state approved materials.

Please be advised that MEDICAID **does not** provide coverage for any services related to **CONTACT LENSES**. The only exception is medical necessity for extremely high powers of prescription which may be approved by special request.

I reasonably understand the above and agree to abide by the guidelines set by Medicaid. MEDICAID will not approve payment for Retinal Photos or contact lens services (in most cases) and I understand that if I elect to have any procedure performed, I will be responsible for payment of the fees at the time of service. I also understand that I am responsible for my co-pay at the time of service.
